Lost Sanity will be doing a beer garden in the park for Park Days. Voting in favor of said motion; Cody Eager-Yes, Phyllis Schickling-Yes, Glen Christensen-Yes and Andy Gappa-Yes. Embars will be fenced in with American Legion for the band in the City parking lot. Voting in favor of said motion; Cody Eager-Yes, Phyllis Schickling-Yes, Glen Christensen-Yes, Andy Gappa-Yes and Mark Slater - Yes. Motion was approved.

A Motion was made by Andy Gappa and seconded by Glen Christensen to approve assigning street address to the storm shelter at Mobile Village as 30 Fifth St. NW. Voting in favor of said motion; Cody Eager-Yes, Phyllis Schickling-Yes, Glen Christensen-Yes, Andy Gappa-Yes and Mark Slater - Yes. Motion was approved.

Ryan has requested that if this issue goes to workshop that he would like to be included.
