

During Extreme Cold Weather... Ways to Prevent Frozen I

IT'S ALL ABOUT PREVENTION

Provide insulation for walls and pipes where necessary. Open kitchen and bathroom cabinets to keep warm air circulating.

Keep the temperature turned up when away from home. Ensure proper seals on all doors and windows to maintain insulation.









Allow a small amount of water to drop from faucets. Assure you and all members of your household know where the main shut off valve is located and how to turn it off in case of emergency.

Keep garage doors closed to avoid escaping heat. Check sprinkler or irrigation systems Make sure you've turned off and fully drained the system.
