#### Project updates

- Due to all the rain days, the contractors have had a slight setback. NO CHANGE - The temporary sewer bypass is still set up from Old Hwy 60 to 2<sup>nd</sup> street south. The sewer bypass will currently run from Old Hwy 60 to 4<sup>th</sup> street on the west side only, with temp water running on BOTH east and west.
- *UPDATE:* Tuesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, GM is now projecting the start of the old water and sewer line removal from Old Hwy 60 SE up to 4<sup>th</sup> street. What this means is that homeowners residing on Center Ave between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> street south, WILL NOT have access to their driveways. Closing the road entirely will ensure that the contractors can work more efficiently without having to worry about traffic flow. Please use side street parking until they are able to get the road open again.
- Tree Story due to a mechanical issue, they will not be back to start tree removal on the north end of center ave. for a couple of weeks.
- Old Hwy 60 South remains closed.

#### Please note:

We still have a few other contractors in town that are working on boring fiber for Christensen Communications and Michels who are working on gas lines for CenterPoint.
