Project updates

- Temporary water lines from 2nd street to 1st street and west of 1st street to abbot will be put in next week. These homeowners will still have access to driveways until the sewer bypass is set up. Once we know when the bypass will be set up, we will reach out via phone and/or door hangers to let homeowners know.
- CenterPoint energy will be in town next week to begin removing their old main on center av. south and 1st street. So, expect some temp road closures in the area.
- Nielsen Blacktopping is still hoping to start with curb installation on 7/28 (weather pending) from Old Hwy 60 up to 5th street
- Crews are planning to get wood chips on North Center and 1st Street cleaned up as soon as they are able.
- Please make sure you have your trash/recycling receptacles labeled with your address so the contractors can make sure they get back to the correct property.
- Please note that when the temporary water line is removed and your residence is hooked up to the new infrastructure, you will notice cloudiness with your fresh water. This is normal. Causes:
 - Air in the system
 - Pressure changes
 - Stirred up sediment- allow your water to run
