Project updates

- NO CHANGE: The week of Sept 2-5 (weather pending) they are projecting to set up the temporary sewer bypass which will affect True Value, the Insurance Center and Enterprise. We have already talked with each of the businesses regarding this portion of the project. While the bypass is set up, expect traffic to be affected in the area. They are projecting this portion to take only a few days. With this being the first week of school, please be sure to talk with your children regarding safety and trying to avoid the area if possible.
- GM has begun work on 1st ST SE from Center to Abbot.
- Nielsen continues to work on concrete driveways and sidewalks. Road paving to begin on South Center soon as well.

**** Please note that they will need to saw-cut after they pour. This generally takes place anywhere between 4-12 hours after concrete is poured and depends on the temperature and weather conditions. This is a critical step in preventing uncontrolled cracking. So, there may be crews saw-cutting after normal work hours.
