Historic Win for Madelia HS Baseball Team



On June 15th, the Madelia Blackhawks secured the State Championship title for Class A baseball, marking a remarkable milestone in the team's history. The program originally began in 1958. Between 1989 and 2005, Madelia was part of a cooperative with Truman High School, competing as the Jayhawks, and achieved fourth place in the state tournament in 1991. The independent program, reinstated in 2017, has been dedicated to developing skills and nurturing talent, paving the way for this triumph.

Our community takes great pride in the Blackhawks, whose dedication and effort have led to this success for Madelia. This

accomplishment embodies the spirit and determination that characterize both our team and town. A heartfelt thank you goes out to the students, coaches, parents, and community members who contributed to making this victory possible.

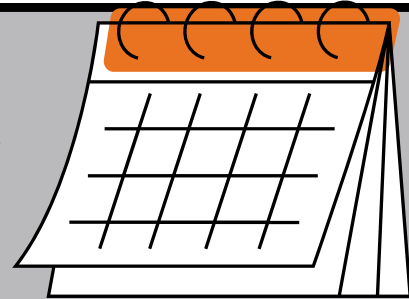
