

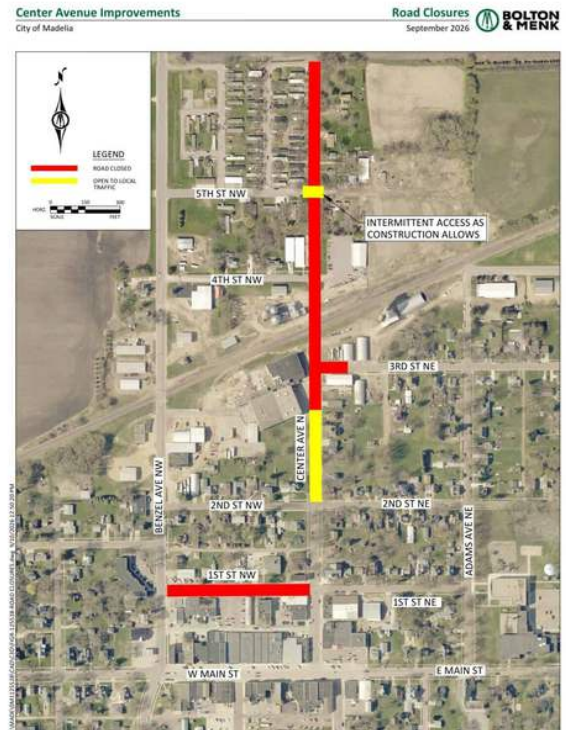

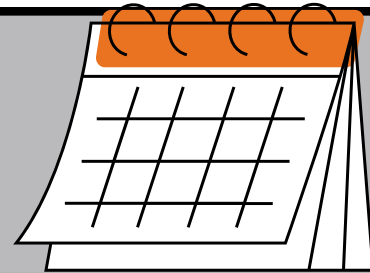

DROP BOX

If you are playing when the Pro-Shed is closed, payment will need to be made using the **drop box**, which is located to the right of the large check-in window at the Pro-Shed.

PUNCH CARD

If you have a punch card and plan to golf before the Pro-Shed is open, please place an "X" over the round number on your punch card for that round. This will indicate that the round has been used. There is no need to drop the punch card in the drop box; you may keep it with you.

DROP-BOX PAYMENTS - HONOR SYSTEM

Please remember that using the drop box for payment is an honor system. We ask that everyone who plays when the Pro-Shed is closed does their part by properly paying for their round.

If it is noticed that the drop-box system is being abused or that golfers are playing without paying, drop-box privileges and open-course play hours may be taken away or adjusted. We would like to continue allowing golfers to enjoy the course during these hours, but this depends on everyone doing their part and paying for their rounds.

NEED A CART BEFORE THE PRO-SHED OPENS?

If you would like to rent a golf cart before the Pro-Shed opens, you may contact City Hall (507-642-3245) to see if a cart can be arranged.

If you plan to do this, please contact City Hall at **least one day in advance** to request and book a cart.

Please note: Contacting City Hall does not guarantee that a cart will be available. Cart rentals before the Pro-Shed opens will depend on staff availability to have a cart prepared and available for you.

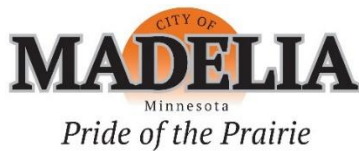

Snow Removal Information

SNOW EMERGENCIES

The City of Madelia may declare a snow emergency after an accumulation of **three (3) or more inches of snow**. During a snow emergency (duration of 12 hours), no person shall park any vehicle on any street in the City of Madelia. No parking in the business district during a snow emergency between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. or until the street has been cleared of snow.

A declared snow emergency allows our street department to quickly and efficiently clear snow from the roadways so that emergency responders and residents can travel safely.

Any vehicle in violation of this Snow Removal Ordinance will be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense. Madelia City Code 70.261

SIDEWALKS

Sidewalks must be cleared of all snow and ice within 24 hours after the end of snowfall by the owner or tenant of any adjacent property.

Properties non-compliant with this ordinance will be billed for the snow removal. Madelia City Ordinance 94.04.01

PLACING SNOW ON A PUBLIC STREET

It is a misdemeanor in the state of Minnesota to deposit snow/ice on any public roadway.
MN State Statute 160.2715
